Clayton County Chairman Jeff Turner Wins 2015-16 Public Leadership Award

Atlanta (Nov. 17, 2015) – Clayton County (GA) Commission Chairman Jeffery E. Turner has been selected as the <u>Safe America Foundation's</u> 2015-16 *WorldSafe Public Leadership Award* recipient. Chairman Turner is receiving the award in recognition of his leadership in helping economic development Atlanta's Southside and his work to enhance the safety and quality of life in the multi-county Southern Crescent.

"The Chairman's leadership in building a more transparent government in Clayton County cannot be understated," noted Len Pagano, Safe America President and CEO. "He has been at the forefront of changes that are positively reorienting the way people throughout Atlanta view the Southside."

When it comes to safety, many issues today concern people. Each year the Safe America Foundation recognizes the top organizations, individuals and nonprofits that have made a significant impact on security and societal stability with its WorldSafe Awards.

Presentation of the award to Mr. Turner is on Saturday, November 21 at Safe America's <u>Play It Safe on the Home Front Gala</u> event at the Omni Hotel, CNN Center in Atlanta, GA. In addition to an awards dinner, the event will showcase Safe America's efforts to enhance safety and preparedness, including its newest initiative, <u>Welcome Home, Heroes</u> – a program to create the unique web portal for returning Veterans as they seek to reintegrate and transition back into civilian life.
