“Clayton County Fire & Emergency Services Sets Open Their New Training Center”

Riverdale, Ga.- On Tuesday, November 17, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. the Clayton County Fire & Emergency Services sets to cut the ribbon, dedicate, and open their doors on the new multi-purpose training facility. In attendance will be state representatives, the County Commission, local leaders, and County department heads.

The new building was part of the approved 2009 SPLOST project. The facility holds four 1,000 square foot classrooms that can convert into a large conference/seminar area that seats 200+ people. Along with the multi-use classrooms will be two EMS training labs utilized for training fire personnel with latest procedures and techniques in emergency medicine. This building also houses a state of the art fitness center for the health and wellness of Clayton County Fire & Emergency Services personnel. The Clayton County Emergency Management Agency will be based out of the new complex and will be the headquarters for the emergency operations, management, and mitigation of large-scale incidents and disasters. This new training facility is the next step in creating a regional training complex that will provide the latest in fire, emergency medical and law enforcement tactical training. The construction of this facility began back in April 2015.

The location of the ceremony is 7810 Highway 85 Riverdale, Ga. 30274 on the training grounds located behind the Headquarters building. The event will go on as scheduled, rain or shine.
