

Chief Magistrate Judge

The Judges of the Superior Court of the Clayton Judicial Circuit are accepting nominations for the appointment of Chief Magistrate Court Judge. The appointment will fill the current unexpired term, ending December 31, 2016, of the resigning Chief Judge.

To be eligible, a person must at the time of appointment, have attained the age of 25 years, been a citizen of Clayton County for one (1) year prior to appointment as Chief Judge, and shall have been an active attorney member in good standing of the State Bar of Georgia for at least four (4) years prior to taking office. The salary of the Chief Magistrate Judge is set at \$121,229.26.
