# Purpose of the Public Meetings

- Introduce the project to the citizens and stakeholders.

# Project Overview

- Mandate residential curbside trash collection by private haulers contracted directly through the county.
- The program will be designed to make residential trash collection mandatory but will offer an expanded residential trash collection service package.  
(recycling, bulk item & yard debris)
- The mandatory service will be collected via the property tax bill.

# Generated Revenue

- The Program will generate revenue via the collection of an administrative fee charged to each residential property.
- The administrative fee will be used to fund the County operation of the Program and supplement the Landfill Enterprise Fund.

# Additional Benefits

Surplus funds from the collection could be used for county beautification programs, including but not limited to:

- Community cleanup initiatives
- Increased Refuse Control funding to support more efficient illegal dump cleanups
- MARTA station cleanups
- Roadway beautifications
