5. *New Business*

A. Certification of 2019 November General Election – City of College Park held November 5, 2019:

Director Dozier informed the Board that Clayton County are responsible for conducting the election for the Clayton County's portion of the election and Fulton County would conduct a General election for their voters.

Clayton County has 433 registered voters in the City of College Park 39 voters cast ballots (participated) in the November General Election. There were no provisional ballots and the turnout 9.01%

Director Dozier informed the Board that no mayoral candidate reached 50% plus 1 of the votes in the November General Election with the combined election results from the City of College Park Fulton Voters. As a result there will be a runoff election to be held December 3, 2019.

**Motion made by, Vice-Chair Foster- Hall, seconded by Secretary Givens to accept the recommendation made by Director Dozier to certify the General and Special elections for the City of College Park, held on November 5, 2019. Vote Unanimous. Motion carried.**

### B. Certification of 2019 November General Election and Special Election – City of Morrow held November 5, 2019:

Director Dozier informed the Board that the City of Morrow has 3849 registered voters 790 cast cards November General Election and Special Election. There were no provisional ballots and the turnout 20.52%

Director Dozier informed the Board that no mayoral candidate reached 50% plus 1 of the votes in the November General Election and Special Election. As a result there will be a runoff election to determine the winner of the mayoral race.

Director Dozier informed the Board that there was a Special Election with Proposed Nonbinding Advisory Referendum on the ballot for the City of Morrow Voters.

Director Dozier informed the Board that no City Council Post 4 candidate reached 50% plus 1 of the votes in the November General Election and Special Election. As a result there will be a runoff election to determine the winner of the City Council Post 4 race.

Director Dozier informed the Board of the conversation held with the municipal clerk of the city of Morrow Yasmin Julio regarding the runoff; Julio confirmed the City of Morrow's Charter regarding elections requires a majority vote in order for a candidate to win an election.

**Motion made by, Vice-Chair Foster- Hall, seconded by Secretary Givens to accept the recommendation made by Director Dozier to certify the General and Special elections for the City of Morrow, held on November 5, 2019. Vote Unanimous. Motion carried.**

Director Dozier informed the Board of the scheduled day for the runoff, December 3, 2019.

Director Dozier informed the Board of the planning conversation held with Fulton County regarding Pre – Election Day activities to ensure that Clayton County and Fulton County City of College Park Voters will have equal opportunity to vote in the December Runoff.

Director Dozier informed the Board that Fulton submitted tentative dates November 25<sup>th</sup> – November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

Director Dozier informed the Board that the turnaround time for the Runoff is short and we will be working to ensure that we meet all deadlines to conduct the election as well as Post-Election activities associated with the November General Election.
