**Magistrate Court of Clayton County's REVISED T.P.O. Process
During Statewide Judicial Emergency
Effective Monday, March 23, 2020**

To insure that victims of domestic violence are provided access to the Courts, during the emergency crisis, which has arisen from the Coronavirus (Covid-19) pandemic, Magistrate Court of Clayton County has worked to create remote hours for victims to apply for both Family Violence Ex Parte Petitions, as well as Stalking Ex-Parte Petitions.

On Monday – Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., individuals in need of protection orders are instructed to go to the Clayton County Police Department Headquarters at 7911 N. McDonough Street, Jonesboro, Georgia 30236, where they will be directed to a designated area. A member of the Securus House team will be available to assist.

Please be aware that Securus House is available to provide safe emergency shelter and comprehensive support services to all victims of domestic violence in Clayton County. The emergency contact number is (770) 961-7233.
