#### Recommendation:

Staff recommended awarding the bid to Nixon Power Services for the lump sum amount of \$46,000.00 for Level 1 and level 2 services and the unit prices as shown on the attached for oil and filter changes on an "as needed – when needed basis". This annual contract is for the time period of March 1, 2018 through February 28, 2019.

The award is contingent upon the Bidder meeting risk management requirement and executing the contract, as well as the Board authorizing the General Manager to sign the contract with the option to renew for a second and third 12 month period by mutual written consent by both parties within 90 days from the expiration date with no change in terms, conditions or bid price.

UPON MOTION by Rodney Givens and second by Marie Barber, it was unanimously

RESOLVED to award the Generator Maintenance Annual Contract to Nixon Power Services for the lump sum amount of \$46,000.00 for Level 1 and Level 2 services; and at the unit prices provided for oil and filter changes on an as needed – when needed basis, contingent upon approval of bonds and insurance as required and to authorize the General Manager to sign the contract.

## **Ultrasonic Meter Sole Source Purchase Recommendation:**

Distribution and Conveyance Manager Jeff Jones presented a recommendation on the Ultrasonic Meter Sole Source Purchase.

CCWA currently has many large water meters in need of replacement in sizes three thru eight inches. In the past we have used mechanical meters. Mechanical meters are compound in nature and have an apparent revenue loss issue. Ultrasonic Meters read down to 1/16 GPM, have no mechanical parts, are smaller/lighter, and are the same cost as mechanical compound meters.

### Recommendation:

Staff recommends installing Ultrasonic Meters in place of Mechanical Meters when replacement is necessary. Master Meter is the only meter manufactory that currently provides three to eight inch size ultrasonic Meters.

UPON MOTION by John Westervelt and second by Rodney Givens, it was unanimously

RESOLVED to approve the Ultrasonic Meter Sole Source Purchase Agreement with Master Meter for the meter size range of 3 inches to 8 inches.

# On-Demand Engineering Services Annual Contract Recommendation:

Program Management and Engineering Manager Kelly Taylor presented a recommendation on the On-Demand Engineering Services Annual Contract.

In October, a Request for Proposals (RFP) for "On-Demand Engineering Services," was advertised. CCWA currently utilizes the services of Jacobs and CH2M Hill Engineers, and additionally has similar master service agreements with four "small" firms (R2T, Engineering Strategies, Inc., Benchmark Management, and Integrated Science and Engineering Inc.) that were selected in a previous procurement. This On-Demand Engineering Services procurement is seeking the services of one or multiple firms to support implementation of our Strategic Master Plan as well as other needs.

CCWA staffed reviewed and scored ten proposals as shown below in Exhibit 1. CCWA staff decided to shortlist and interview the top four firms. During the evaluation process, the merger of Jacobs and CH2M was completed and CCWA decided to consider these two teams as one for the shortlist interviews. After the interview process which involved CCWA staff and Board Members Cephas Jackson, Marie Barber and John Chafin, the final scores are listed in exhibit 2.

CCWA staff and the Board Committee recommend awarding the annual services contract to Jacobs and Hazen & Sawyer.

The recommendation includes allowing CCWA staff to negotiate billing rate schedule(s) with Jacobs and Hazen and Sawyer to a comparative nature along with authorizing the CCWA General Manager to execute a three year Master Service Agreement (MSA) after receipt and approval of each firm's insurance requirements. The MSA will include two additional one year renewal terms.

# CCWA Sewer Use Ordinance and Local Limits Evaluation Recommendation:

Water Reclamation Manager Chris Hamilton presented a recommendation on the CCWA Sewer Use Ordinance and Local Limits Evaluation.

The Clayton County sewer use ordinance sets forth rules and regulations for users of CCWA's sewer system and water reclamation facilities. The ordinance authorizes the issuance of wastewater discharge permits; provides for monitoring, compliance, and enforcement activities; establishes administrative review procedures; requires user reporting; and provides for the setting of fees for the equitable distribution of costs resulting from the program/ordinance. In addition, the ordinance enables CCWA to comply with its NPDES permits requirements and any other Federal or State laws. Ultimately the ordinance is designed to protect CCWA's sewer system and water reclamation facilities.

Periodically the ordinance requires updates and revisions to reflect certain changes or conditions within the ordinance. CCWA's NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) operating permits for its water reclamation facilities requires that the local limits for certain pollutants discharged into the sewer system from industries be evaluated for needed changes during a permit cycle which is every five years. The local

limits evaluation is an integral part of CCWA's pretreatment program and is needed to protect the sewer system, water reclamation facilities, human health and the environment.

## Sewer Use Ordinance Revisions:

Pollutant limits were recalculated based on current conditions and revisions are listed below. Also included in the revisions are the following items:

- At the Manager's discretion, any permitted significant or categorical industrial user may be required to install a flow meter that measures instantaneous maximum flow rate in gallons per minute (GPM);
- Change ordinance to read POTW instead of sanitary sewer;
- Remove LAS (Land Application System) from ordinance.
