The following report represents a summary and recap of major operations and activities that we have completed or are on going within Elections and Registration for the month of April 2019 and activities since the last board meeting. The priorities were centered on Post - March Special Election activities, packing in preparation of renovations, training and deadline driven tasks.

ELECTIONS

PERSONNEL STAFFING:

We have 3 Part Time positions vacant and are utilizing temporary/seasonal Staff to assist us in our pre/post-election activities.

The Office of Youth Services has collaborated with Eckerd Connect again in an Internship Project. The Department submitted a request to receive an Intern. We are awaiting the next steps from Eckerd Connect to schedule a start date with the new Intern.

STAFFING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING:

Deadline driven task from the redistribution of daily operations continue to receive priority training which included Staff Training. Additionally, Staff attended the following trainings since the last Board Meeting: Local Filing Officer, Personnel, GEOA/VRAG Conference Staff, and Youth Survey Institute Training.

Election Center Special Workshop and Crisis Management Renewal Course:

Director Dozier attended a Special Workshop on Improving the Integrity of Voter Registration and Election Operations as well as completed a Certified Elections Registration Administrator (CERA) Certification Renewal course on Crisis Management with the Election Center.

The workshop was held April 24 – 28, 2019 in Virginia Beach, Virginia. The completion of the workshop and course fulfills some requirements to renew Director Dozier's the Elections Center national election administrator's certification.

RENOVATION OF ELECTION CENTER/FORMER 911 BUNKER:

Construction of the Election/IT Data Center is 80% complete. An update will be provided at a future meeting. Director Ben Hopkins is scheduled to attend the next Board Meeting to discuss renovations as directed by the Board at the April Meeting.

2019 ELECTION UPDATES:

The City of Riverdale and Jonesboro are interested in entering into an Intergovermental Agreegment with the Clayton County Board of Elections to use our voting equipment to conduct their 2019 Municipal elections. We will provide the IGAs to present to the Board at the meeting for consideration.

2020 GEORGIA ASSOCIATION OF VOTER REGISTRATION AND ELECTION OFFICIALS (GAVREO) CONFERENCE:

The 2020 GAVREO conference will be held December 8 - 11, 2019 at the Savannah Marriott Riverfront. We plan to increase the number of Staff attending due to training sessions on the new voting equipment. If a Board Member is interested in attending, please let us know. Hotel reservations can be made starting May 1, 2019 online.

REGISTRATION

VOTER REGISTRATION:

As of May 1, there are 191,926 (176,800 Active; 15,126 Inactive) voters in Clayton County.

VOTER REGISTRATION BACKLOG:

Director Dozier would like to commend the Staff for processing over 18,330 voter registration applications backlog within three weeks. The backlog was created due to the voter registration deadline for the 2019 March Special Election.

FELON LIST

State law requires counties to review felon reports and to conduct hearings for those voters with matching data that raises questions regarding their eligibility to vote in accordance with O.C. G.A. 21-2-228. All reports must be processed in accordance with O.C.G.A. 21-2-231.

NATIONAL CHANGE OF ADDRESS (NCOA) CONFIRMATION NOTICIES:

In accordance with O.C.G.A. § 21-2-233 the NCOA notices will be provided to the county to mail. The Board of Elections will receive and mail an estimated 11,607 NCOA Confirmation notices at an estimated cost of \$5,687.43 to those impacted.

NCOA confirmation notices will be mailed to electors whose addresses have changed with the United States Postal Service but does not match the elector's address in Voter Registration. Due to the change in the NCOA process we received two reports for confirmation notices.

The State Elections Division requested for each county to mail the NCOA confirmation notices on the same day. We anticipate receiving the notices in mid-May and are awaiting the date to mail. We will receive a training Webinar of the new process from the State Elections Division during the month of May. The Elections Office will process the confirmation notices as received. We will provide an update to the Board at the next Board Meeting.
