RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL FACILITY USE REQUEST FOR SPECTRUM ABILITIES, INC.; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Spectrum Abilities Inc., (“Vendor”) is requesting that the Board of Commissioners (“Board”) approve a special facility use request for the use of space at the Flint River Community Center (“Facility”) to provide functional life skills and recreational activities to teens and young adults (“Event”) for one Saturday per month from January 2023 through March 2023; and

WHEREAS, Spectrum Abilities Inc. is a non-profit 501c3 organization that provides education, community access events, resource navigation, and social and recreational programs for individuals (youth and young adults) with an autism diagnosis and other special needs on the Southside of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the estimated number of participants is ten (10); and

WHEREAS, the Senior Services Department is asking that Spectrum Abilities use a space at the Facility at no cost; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by authorizing the use of the Flint River Community Center for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners (“Board”) hereby grants a special facility use request for Spectrum Abilities Inc, (“Vendor”) to use space at the Flint River Community Center to provide functional life skills/recreational activities to teens and young adults for one Saturday per month from January 2023 through March 2023, at no cost. The use of the Flint River Community Center for such purposes is contingent on the availability of space at the time of the Vendor’s request.

Section 2. The Board authorizes the Chairman to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, as may be required.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
