RESOLUTION NO. 2023-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, THROUGH THE CLAYTON COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM, TO RESTRUCTURE THE LIBRARY SYSTEM'S STAFF DEVELOPMENT DAY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County, through the Clayton County Library System (the "Library"), wishes to restructure the Library's Staff Development Day from six (6) 3-hour days per year to one (1) 8 hour day per year; and

WHEREAS, the Library recommends closing one (1) 8-hour day per year starting the second Monday in October 2023 to conduct Staff Development Training; and

WHEREAS, this training schedule will allow more efficient utilization of time and resources, varied, comprehensive and thorough topics for training, and is a widely used format by other libraries/organizations; and

WHEREAS, the day requested would be Indigenous Peoples' Day; and

WHEREAS, there is no fiscal or funding impact to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by restructuring the Library's Staff Development Day for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, through the Clayton County Library System, to restructure the Library System's Staff Development Day from six (6) 3-hour days per year to one (1) 8 hour day per year. The Board of Commissioners hereby

authorizes the Chairman, or his designee, to execute any documents, and otherwise perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
