RESOLUTION NO. 2023-32

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF GEORGIA COUNCIL OF ACCOUNTABILITY COURT JUDGES FUNDING COMMITTEE AND THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR THE CLAYTON COUNTY FAMILY TREATMENT ACCOUNTABILITY COURT PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (the "County"), on behalf of the Clayton County Juvenile Court Family Treatment Accountability Court Program (the "Family Treatment Court"), has been awarded grant funds in the amount of up to \$300,000.00 from the State of Georgia Criminal Justice Coordinating Council ("CJCC"), and the County now wishes to accept those funds; and

WHEREAS, there is no local cash match required from the County, and therefore no financial impact upon the County; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is July 1, 2024, until June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Family Treatment Court is an accountability court that will address parents with substance abuse concerns who have dependency cases in Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Family Treatment Court will provide treatment and resources to

assist the participants with addressing their addiction and provide resources to improve their quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the Family Treatment Court's Accountability Court Program is an 18-24 month program that includes treatment, court monitoring, community service, random screening and support services; and

WHEREAS, the Family Treatment Court will serve to help parents of Clayton County to address their substance abuse concerns with treatment and resources, and by helping the parents, the program will strengthen the families empowering them to be more productive, contributing citizens of Clayton County. and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by accepting the grant funds, as described above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF

CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept grant funds in the amount of up to \$300,000.00 on behalf of the Clayton County Adult Felony Drug Accountability Court Program, for the purpose of supporting program needs, with no local cash match required from the County.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute all necessary documents, and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense as necessary.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
