RESOLUTION NO. 2023-46

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF GEORGIA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT FOR THE CLAYTON COUNTY DRUG COURT PROGRAM'S CERTIFIED ADDICTION COUNSELOR; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Judicial Circuit is requesting authorization from the Board of Commissioners to apply for and, if awarded, accept grant funds in the amount of \$2,174.35 from the State of Georgia Criminal Justice Coordinating Council ("CJCC"); and

WHEREAS, there is no financial impact to the County as there is no local cash match required for this Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Grant funds will help provide for the purchase of technology equipment for the Clayton County Drug Court Program's ("Drug Court") Certified Addiction Counselor; and

WHEREAS, this Grant, if awarded, will support the purchase of certain technical equipment, including a Lenovo Thinkbook, Lenovo Docking Station, Logitech Wireless

Desktop Keyboard & Mouse Set, and Epson DS 730N Document Scanner; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned equipment will support the Drug Court's utilization of a web-based database to collect treatment and counseling notes, as well as attach treatment related documents, for use by the Certified Addiction Counselor; and

WHEREAS, accepting this grant, if awarded, will further support Clayton County's Drug Court to meet the individual counseling needs of program participants who are dealing with a substance use disorder, whether it be drugs or alcohol; and

WHEREAS, this supplemental grant is being applied for under existing CJCC Grant Number J23-8-011, the grant period being July 1, 2022, until June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by accepting the grant funds, as described above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County ("County") to apply for and, if awarded, accept grant funds in the amount of \$2,174.35 on behalf of the Clayton County Judicial Circuit, for the purpose of providing participants in the various Clayton County Accountability Courts Programs with substance use disorder counseling workbooks in order to meet the individual participants counseling needs. There is no local cash match required from the County.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute all necessary documents, and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense as

necessary.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
