RESOLUTION NO. 2023-128

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, THROUGH THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT'S OFFICE OF DIGITAL EQUITY, TO ACCEPT CASH AND IN-KIND DONATIONS FROM VARIOUS COMMUNITY MEMBERS AND STAKEHOLDERS TO FUND THE COST OF FOOD AND SUPPLIES FOR THE OFFICE OF DIGITAL EQUITY COMMUNITY BLOCK PARTY ON SATURDAY, JULY 1, 2023; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO ACCEPT THE DONATIONS ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Office of Digital Equity has been functioning as a division of the Department of Information Technology since July 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, to commemorate the one-year anniversary of the Office, the Department of Information Technology will host a free community block party event at the Technology Services & Training Center located at 9181 Poston Rd, Jonesboro, GA 30236 on July 1, 2023, from 10:00am - 2:00pm; and

WHEREAS, the block party will provide free entertainment, food, music, and giveaways, including free laptops to Clayton County residents; and

WHEREAS, Information Technology staff has received pledges and donations from various community members and stakeholders, including: (1) 50 MARTA Breeze

Cards, (2) One \$500 gift card from Kroger to purchase food and supplies for the event, (3) \$100 in-kind donation from Food Depot (Lovejoy) for food/supplies, (4) In-kind donation of catering 100 guests from Slutty Vegan (Jonesboro) via food truck or on-hand Slutty Vegan staff on the day of the event, (5) In-kind donation of five hours of free DJ service from Marshall Jones, (6) \$50 donation from Performer Chris Marlay, (7) In-kind donation of food and supplies from Mrs. Vanessa Fogle; and

WHEREAS, the donation does not require a match of funds from Clayton County and there is no financial impact to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by the acceptance of the donations for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, through the Information Technology Department's Office of Digital Equity, to accept cash and in-kind donations from various community members and stakeholders to fund the cost of food and supplies for the Office of Digital Equity Community Block Party on Saturday, July 1, 2023, at the Technology Services & Training Center located at 9181 Poston Rd, Jonesboro, GA 30236 from 10:00am - 2:00pm.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to accept the donation on behalf of Clayton County and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




