RESOLUTION NO. 2023-155

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, THROUGH CLAYTON COUNTY FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE ATLANTA FIRE RESCUE TRAINING ACADEMY TO PROVIDE CLINICAL EXPERIENCE TRAINING; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County, through Clayton County Fire & Emergency Services, wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (“MOA”) with the Atlanta Fire Rescue Training Academy (“AFRTA”) to provide clinical experience training as part of the AFRTA initial Emergency Medical Service (“EMS”) education platform; and

WHEREAS, this is a mutual agreement that provides a clinical learning environment for AFRTA EMS students to complete programmatic EMS clinical requirements; and

WHEREAS, the instruction and practice are intended to benefit the AFRTA students at Clayton County EMS in accomplishing their educational goals and to create a highly trained workforce; and

WHEREAS, there is no cost to Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by entering into the MOA for the stated purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, through Clayton County Fire & Emergency Services, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Atlanta Fire Rescue Training Academy to provide clinical experience training as part of the AFRTA initial Emergency Medical Service education platform. The MOA shall be in substantially the same form attached hereto, subject to such minor changes, insertions, or deletions as the County Attorney and/or Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement, and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


