RESOLUTION NO. 2023-243

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, THROUGH THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO APPLY FOR AND, IF AWARDED, ACCEPT THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 GEORGIA GANG ACTIVITY PROSECUTION (GAP) GRANT FUNDS TO PURCHASE A CLEARVIEW ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE FACIAL RECOGNITION IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM TO ENHANCE CLAYTON COUNTY'S LAW ENFORCEMENT TECHNOLOGY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department desires to apply for and, if awarded, accept the Fiscal Year 2024 Georgia Gang Activity Prosecution (GAP) Grant Funds (Grant) in the amount of \$65,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this Grant will be used to purchase the Clearview Artificial Intelligence Facial Recognition Identification system to enhance law enforcement technology to improve crime solving within Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Clearview Artificial Intelligence Facial Recognition Identification system is a revolutionary, investigative platform that enables quicker identifications and apprehensions to help solve and prevent crimes, helping to make our community safer; and

WHEREAS, there is no local match required of Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will be best served by participating in the Grant and purchasing the specified item.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, through the Clayton County Police Department, to apply for and, if awarded, accept the Fiscal Year 2024 Georgia Gang Activity Prosecution (GAP) Grant Funds, in the amount of \$65,000.00, to purchase a Clearview Artificial Intelligence Facial Identification system to enhance Clayton County's law enforcement technology.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the grant agreement.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
