RESOLUTION NO. 2023-269

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, THROUGH ITS OFFICE OF RESILIENCE AND SUSTAINABILITY, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT DISASTER RECOVERY FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, THROUGH THE GEORGIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT & HOMELAND SECURITY AGENCY FOR DIRECT ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH HURRICANE IRMA; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Office of Resilience and Sustainability (“ORS”) wishes to apply for, and if awarded, accept grant funds in the amount of up to \$12,230.45 from Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) funds, distributed through the Georgia Emergency Management & Homeland Security Agency (“GEMA/HS”), for Direct Administrative Costs associated with Hurricane Irma; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County currently has an active FEMA and GEMA/HS Direct Administrative Cost Project for DR-4338, otherwise known as Hurricane Irma, a 2017 hurricane that caused damage in Clayton County after moving into Georgia post landfall in Florida; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned funding shall only be used by ORS for activities that improve future public assistance program operations, specifically to support the creation of a Debris Management & Monitoring Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by accepting the aforementioned grant funds for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of Clayton County Office of Resilience and Sustainability to apply for and, if awarded, accept grant funds in the amount of up to \$12,230.45 from Federal Emergency Management Agency funds, distributed through the Georgia Emergency Management & Homeland Security Agency, for Direct Administrative Costs associated with Hurricane Irma. The Board also authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget to reflect appropriations and expenditures all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




