RESOLUTION NO. 2024-102

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY THROUGH THE CLAYTON COUNTY CENTRAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH BROWN SUGAR SWEETS, LLC; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (“County”), through the Clayton County Central Services Department, wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) (Exhibit A) with Brown Sugar Sweets, LLC (“Vendor”), a food truck vendor, which will provide food items for purchase at events held by the County through the County’s various departments; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the proposed MOU is to establish the terms and conditions under which the Vendor will be allowed to provide food to patrons during the County’s planned events; and

WHEREAS, the County shall provide and reimburse vouchers to the aforementioned Vendor for food items purchased by County employees in an amount to be determined per County employee; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by entering into the Memorandum of Understanding with Brown Sugar Sweets, LLC to provide food services for the planned County events.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) with Brown Sugar Sweets, LLC, a food truck service, to provide food services for purchase at planned events held by Clayton County through its various departments. The MOU shall be in substantially the same form attached hereto as “Exhibit A,” subject to such minor changes, insertions, or deletions as the County Attorney and/or Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve. The Board also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense relating thereto. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chairman, or his designee, to execute the MOUs, with such minor changes, insertions, or deletions, and otherwise to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
