APPROVED POST SUMMARY MINUTES

PRESENT: Chair Wesley, Vice-Chair Dorothy Foster Hall, Secretary Johnson, Treasurer Givens, Board Member Patricia Pullar, Director Shauna Dozier, Supervisor Trivis Houston, Attorney Charles Reed, and Elections & Registration Assistant Brianna Garrett.

REGULAR BUSINESS BOARD MEETING

1. *Chair called the meeting to order.*

2. *Moment of silence observed.*

3. *Adoption of Agenda:*

Motion made by Vice-Chair Foster-Hall, seconded by Treasurer Givens. Vote Unanimous. Motion carried.

4. *Approval of May 12, 2020 Regular Business Meeting minutes.*

Motion made by Treasurer Givens seconded by Vice-Chair Foster-Hall to approve the May 12, 2020 Regular Called Board Meeting Minutes with corrections as noted. Vote Unanimous. Motion carried.

5. *PUBLIC COMMENT:* Citizens will be given a three minute maximum time limit to speak before the Board of Elections and Registration about various topics, issues, and concerns. Public comments will be limited to thirty (30) minutes. Following thirty minutes of hearing from the public, the Board of Elections and Registration will allow the remainder of citizens who have signed up to be heard at the next regular business meeting.

There was no public comment.

6. *Old Business:*

A. Board Directives as necessary.

Director Dozier informed the Board that there are no Board directives to review.

7. *New Business*

A. Director's Report & Election Update

Director Dozier informed the Board that she has been in contact with Forest Park 5 located at Victory Point International Ministries and that they have agreed to continue the usage of their building through the August 11, 2020 Runoff Election.

B. Advanced Voting Locations- August 11, 2020 Runoff Election

Director Dozier informed the Board that she would like to recommend the usage of the Forest Park library as an advanced Voting location due to the District 7 runoff being districted for the majority of Forest Park. Contact has been made with the Library Director, Rosalind Lett to accommodate the usage of the building as a voting site.

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Motion made by Treasurer Givens, seconded by Vice-Chair Foster-Hall, to accept the recommendation made by Director Dozier to utilize Forest Park Library located at 4812 West Street, Forest Park, GA 30297 as a voting site for the August 11, 2020 Runoff Election. Vote Unanimous. Motion Carried.

C. Hearing to remove felons.

There were no felons to remove.

D. Removal of deceased from the elector's list.

Motion made by Board Member Pullar, seconded by Vice-Chair Foster-Hall, to remove 80 deceased voters from the electors' list. Vote Unanimous. Motion passed.

Board Member Pullar made a recommendation that the Elections & Registration Office collaborates with Human Resources to establish a plan that allows for the deployment of employees on Election Days to be utilized in polling locations as necessary.

Director Dozier informed the Board that the office will utilize Information Technology personnel as additional technicians on Election Day. In addition, voter education will be pushed to notify the public to utilize the 180 days before an election to submit an absentee ballot application and use the advanced voting hours, which also include Sunday voting.

Treasurer Givens inquired on notifying the public on how to check the status of their absentee ballots online.

Director Dozier informed the Board that a media informing voters on how to check their status using the state's online portal was released to all county social media platforms, as well as constituents and stakeholders.

Motion made by Board Member Pullar, seconded by Secretary Johnson, for Chair Wesley to recommend that Director Dozier inquire about county employees being utilized as necessary to assist with Election Day duties. Vote Unanimous. Motion carried.

8. Executive session:

There was no executive session.

9. Adjourn.

Motion made by Treasurer Givens to adjourn the Regular Board Meeting at 6:18 P.M. Motion seconded by Secretary Johnson. Vote Unanimous. Motion passed.


