RESOLUTION NO. 2007 - 72

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE OPERATION OF THE CODE ENFORCEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OF CLAYTON COUNTY TO THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF ALL PERSONNEL CURRENTLY IN THE CODE ENFORCEMENT DIVISION AND RELATED EQUIPMENT TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE PERSONNEL DIRECTOR TO DO ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE TRANSFER OF SUCH PERSONNEL; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENTS TO REFLECT THE LINE ITEM TRANSFERS RELATING THERETO; TO AUTHORIZE ALL OTHER ACTS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the inspection and issuance of citations related to the health, safety and welfare of the county is handled by the Code Enforcement Division which is currently a division of the Community Development Department of Clayton County under the sole jurisdiction of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has a strong interest in promoting the traditional police power goals of health, safety, morals, and the general welfare of the community; and in particular the security of the public from violations and the facilitation of proper enforcement and investigations of code violations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the citizens, and the County will best be served by transferring the operation of the Code Enforcement Division from the Community Development Department to the control and jurisdiction of the Police Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the transfer of the operation of the Code Enforcement Division, (including all personnel and related equipment) of the Community Development Department under the jurisdiction of the Board of Commissioners to the Clayton County Police Department. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Personnel Director to do all acts necessary to effectuate the transfer of all personnel currently in the Code Enforcement Division to the Police Department. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the respective budgets of the Community Development and Police Departments to reflect the line item transfers relating thereto. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes all other acts required to implement this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the next regular payroll cycle from today's date, Monday, May 7th, 2007.




