RESOLUTION NO. 2007-167

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 2007-138 ADOPTING A MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR LAND USE AMENDMENTS, AS WELL AS APPLICATIONS FOR REZONING OF PARCELS OF LAND OR BUILDINGS, AS THEY RELATE TO EXISTING OR PROPOSED RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES WITHIN ALL ZONING DISTRICTS WITHIN CLAYTON COUNTY TO BE IN EFFECT FROM NOVEMBER 30, 2007, THROUGH AND INCLUDING FEBRUARY 3, 2008, TO ADOPT AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County previously approved Resolution 2007-138 extending the previously adopted Moratorium on the acceptance of applications for land use amendments as well as applications for rezoning of parcels of land or buildings as they relate to existing or proposed residential properties within all zoning districts in the county; and

WHEREAS, the suspension for the acceptance of applications for land use amendments and the rezoning of parcels of land or buildings relating to existing or proposed residential properties was set to expire on November 30, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the County's best interest and the objectives provided herein can be best served by amending Resolution 2007-138 to provide that the above referenced Moratorium should remain in effect through and including February 3, 2008, with all other terms of the previous Resolution remaining the same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. Resolution 2007-138 is amended to be extended through February 3, 2008.

All other terms of Resolution 2007-138 shall remain the same.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board




