RESOLUTION NO. 2009 – 76

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONDUCT A DAM IMPACT STUDY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is charged with the oversight of dams located within the state; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources inspects and evaluates the safety of dams and will conduct impact studies of dams upon the receipt of a formal request from local governments, at no cost to the local governments; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County desires that the Department conduct a study of the Rock Hill Lake dam; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by formally requesting such a study.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby requests that the Georgia Department of Natural Resources conduct a study of the Rock Hill Lake Dam to determine its condition and its impact on surrounding property.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute any required documents and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




