## RESOLUTION NO. 2013-272

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A REVISED MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ATLANTA PROVIDING FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION PROTECTION, PREVENTION, RESCUE, HAZARDOUS MATERIALS, AND SUPPORT SERVICES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the laws of Georgia authorize local governments to provide mutual aid; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement to provide mutual aid in emergencies subject to the availability of resources on February 5, 2002;

WHEREAS, the city of Atlanta has revised its mutual aid agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by entering into the revised Agreement for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton

County to enter into a reciprocal revised Agreement with the City of Atlanta to provide for fire suppression protection, prevention, rescue, hazardous materials, and support services.

Section 2. This Resolution and the attached revised Mutual Aid Agreement shall be effective on the date of approval of this Resolution by the Board of Commissioners. The Chairman is authorized to execute the revised Mutual Aid Agreement and to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution.
