RESOLUTION NO. 2014-51

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO APPLY FOR AND IF AWARDED ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE ASSOCIATION COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GEORGIA (“ACCG”) FOR THE GEORGIA COUNTY INTERNSHIP PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH ACCG PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE PROGRAM WILL BE ADMINISTERED; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Civic Affairs Foundation (the “Foundation”) is a nonprofit organization established by the Association County Commissioners of Georgia (“ACCG”) for the purpose of strengthening Georgia counties by undertaking programs and projects to enhance citizen education, encouraging civic engagement and community improvement, and promoting participation in government; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation operates the Georgia County Internship Program (“GCIP”) which offers grants to counties to hire college and university students for specific projects that will benefit County government and citizens; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for Clayton County hiring an eligible intern through the GCIP, ACCG will provide funding to the County to be exclusively used to pay the wages and employment costs for the intern; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by submitting a grant application and, if grant funds are awarded, entering into the Agreement with ACCG for the reasons contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to apply for and, if awarded, accept grant funds from ACCG for the Georgia County Internship Program. The Board also authorizes the County to enter into an Agreement with ACCG providing for the terms and conditions under which the Program will be administered. The Board authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
