ORDINANCE NO. 2017-67

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, PART II, CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE I “IN GENERAL”, SECTION 2-6 “EMPLOYEE TRAVEL”; SUBSECTION (B) TO SPECIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER AS IT RELATES TO EMPLOYEE TRAVEL REQUESTS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The Code of Clayton County, Georgia, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part II, Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article I “In General”, Sec. 2-6 “Employee Travel” subsection (b) which shall amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-6. Employee Travel.

....

- (b) The Chief Financial Officer is charged with the responsibility of administering the policy and preparing forms necessary or incidental to accurate accounting in order that the intent of this section shall be fully satisfied. In the absence of a specific guideline governing a travel request, the county will default to the most recently-adopted version of the Statewide Travel Policy enacted by the State of Georgia (or its equivalent) in processing employee travel requests.

Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If this Ordinance in whole or in part is determined to be unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
