ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 8

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY PART I, CHAPTER 42 "FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION", ARTICLE IV "OPEN BURNING", SO AS TO DELETE SECTION 42-92(b) "MEDICAL EXEMPTION"; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part I, Chapter 42 "Fire Prevention And Protection", Article IV "Open Burning", so as to delete Section 42-92(b) "Medical Exemptions" in its entirety.

<u>Section 2.</u> All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective on immediately upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
