RESOLUTION NO. 2019-161

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH RING; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, theft of packages on doorsteps has increased significantly as online shopping and delivery of packages has increased; and

WHEREAS, Ring has created a software program called "Neighbors App" that uses the address of the app owner to create a radius around their home and, if anyone shares an alert on the Neighbors App about a crime or safety issue in the radius, neighbors will also get a notification on their phones and tablets; and

WHEREAS, Ring has offered to partner with homeowner associations, block watches and other community groups to help reduce crime in neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, Ring has offered to provide their Neighbors portal to the Clayton County Police Department free of charge to assist law enforcement personnel in catching thieves; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the citizens of the County to enter into this agreement with Ring and the Board desires to enter into an agreement with Ring to enhance its law enforcement efforts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an agreement with Ring to have access to the Neighbors Portal for law enforcement

purposes only. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute any agreement and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as recommended by the County Attorney and as the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve.


Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


