RESOLUTION NO. 2020-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDED AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH MEDICAL EXAMINER AND CORONER SERVICES ARE RENDERED TO CLAYTON COUNTY IN THE ABSENCE OF A CORONOR; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Bureau of Investigation (the "GBI") in the absence of the Clayton County Coroner has been providing medical examiner and coroner services to Clayton County ("the County") by agreement ("the Agreement") since 2001; and

WHEREAS, GBI and the County (collectively referred to as "the Parties") have renegotiated the terms of the Agreement to reflect the cost of providing medical examiner and coroner services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree to enter into this Second Amendment to reflect the terms and conditions under which the GBI will provide medical examiner and coroner services to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by entering into the amended Agreement for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an amended Agreement with the Georgia Bureau of Investigation providing for medical examiner and coroner services to Clayton County in the absence of the Clayton County Coroner. The Agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A," subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as the County Attorney and/or Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement, with such minor changes, insertions or deletions, and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
