RESOLUTION NO. 2020-211

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO CONVEY AN EASEMENT TO GEORGIA POWER FOR THE BATTLE CREEK ROAD WIDENING PROJECT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Transportation and Development Department wishes to enter into an easement agreement with Georgia Power for the Battle Creek Road Widening Project (the "project"); and

WHEREAS, the easement is necessary for Georgia Power to properly relocate their utility facility that conflicts with the project; and

WHEREAS, the County property in question is Parcel 13179B D030, which is located adjacent to the existing intersection of Battle Creek Road and Valley Hill Road; and

WHEREAS, the utility relocation plan at this location requires a "down support anchor" attached to the utility pole as the utility lines change direction and the use of support anchors for utility lines are common and routine; and

WHEREAS, the easement is needed at this location due to the alignment of the utility lines and the available right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, to properly locate the anchor, the distance required is outside the right-of-way, thus the need for the easement; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by conveying an easement to Georgia Power for the purposes set forth within.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of Clayton County Transportation and Development department to enter into an easement agreement with Georgia Power for the Battle Creek Road Widening Project. A description of the easement to be conveyed is more fully set forth in the attached documents. The Board also authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


