RESOLUTION NO. 2020-214

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH KAISER PERMANENTE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE RECONNECTING WITH WHY PILOT PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN, OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE MOU; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the current environment often isolates law enforcement officers from one another and the community; and

WHEREAS, Kaiser Permanente created the Pilot Program “Reconnecting with Why” to help law enforcement officers develop creative and healthy communication strategies, promote good self-care and reinvigorate relationships with peers and the community; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department has been invited to participate in this valuable program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by participation in this Pilot Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, or the Chief of Police as the Chairman’s designee to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Kaiser Permanente to participate in the Reconnecting with the

Why Pilot Program. Clayton County will provide a group of officers for the pilot program and a facility with the appropriate environment to conduct the workshop without cost to Kaiser Permanente. Kaiser Permanente will provide the instructors, all required materials and refreshments without cost to Clayton County.


Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman, or the Chief of Police as his designee, to execute any documents necessary, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.


Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


