RESOLUTION NO. 2021-49

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COMMISSIONER GAIL HAMBRICK TO PARTNER WITH REVEREND JOSEPH WHEELER TO HOST THE 4TH ANNUAL LOVEFEST GOSPEL CONCERT AT THE CLAYTON COUNTY INTERNATIONAL PARK ST. THOMAS PAVILION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Reverend Joseph Wheeler (the "Promoter") desires to host the 4th Annual Lovefest Gospel Concert (the "Event"); and

WHEREAS, the Promoter, in partnership with Commissioner Gail Hambrick, wishes to use the Clayton County International Park St. Thomas Pavilion (the "Facility") to host the Event; and

WHEREAS, the Event is scheduled for April 17, 2021 from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Facility will be utilized between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. to set up and break down the Event; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated number of people attending the Event is 150; and

WHEREAS, the Event will have music, food, vendors, and will be free and open to the public; and

WHEREAS, Covid-19 safety guidelines will be followed in the below manner: all seating will be marked in a socially distanced manner, hand sanitizer will be provided on site, the lines for food vendors will be marked 6ft apart, all microphones will be cleaned periodically after every performance, and all guests will be required to wear masks; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by authorizing Commissioner Gail Hambrick and the Promoter to host the Event and to use the Facility to facilitate the Event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Commissioner Gail Hambrick to partner with Reverend Joseph Wheeler to host the 4th annual Lovefest Gospel Concert at the Clayton County International Park St. Thomas Pavilion on April 17, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and also authorizes the Chairman to execute any documents and perform any other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners and is contingent upon complete satisfaction of all insurance requirements, if any, prior to the initial event date as provided by the Clayton County Risk Management Department.




