RESOLUTION NO. 2021-43

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO GRANT A SPECIAL FACILITY USE REQUEST TO ALLOW A COMMUNITY A- FAIR TO HOST ACA SPRING BREAK FESTIVAL IN THE GERALD MATTHEWS COMPLEX PARKING LOT AREA; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a Special Facility Use Request (the "Request") was received from A Community A-Fair (the "Promoter") for use of the Clayton County Gerald Matthews Complex (the "Facility") for the purpose of hosting an ACA Spring Break Festival (the "Event") March 29, 2021 through April 12, 2021 in the Gerald Matthews Complex parking lot area; and

WHEREAS, the Event is scheduled for April 2, 2021 through April 11, 2021 with the days and times outlined below:

Monday-Thursday: 5pm – 10pm

Fridays: 5pm-11pm

Saturdays: 1pm-11pm

Sundays: 2pm-10pm; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated number of people attending the Event is 5000; and

WHEREAS, the Event will include carnival rides for adults and children, games, food, staging, and live entertainment including a DJ; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter will be responsible for keeping the sound levels below 110db1 as stated in the Clayton County Noise Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Covid-19 safety guidelines will be followed, and a written plan/proposal will be submitted to Parks and Recreation thirty days prior to the event; and

WHEREAS, a vendor will need to attach to a water source, provide portable bathrooms, provide trash cans and dumpsters, and provide uniformed Clayton County off duty law enforcement officers with a patrol car during operating event hours; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation department recommends that the Promoter be charged \$6,000.00 for the Event, \$20 per hour could be applied if Clayton County staff is required, and the Promoter will have to pay for the use of Clayton County off duty law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by granting the Request to use the Facility and allowing the Promoter to facilitate this event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to grant a Special Facility Use Request to A Community A-Fair to host an ACA Spring Break Festival at the Clayton County Gerald Matthews Complex, and also authorizes the Chairman to execute any documents and perform any other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.


Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners and is contingent upon complete satisfaction of all insurance requirements, if any, prior to the initial event date as provided by the Clayton County Risk Management Department.
