RESOLUTION NO. 2021-73

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO GRANT A SPECIAL FACILITY USE REQUEST TO ALLOW NEIGHBORHOOD FOREST TO ARRANGE FOR TREE DISTRIBUTION WITHIN CLAYTON COUNTY LIBRARY SERVICE'S NORMAL FUNCTIONING WORKING HOURS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, urban and residential trees beautify neighborhoods, increase property values, reduce utility bills by providing shade or serving as a windbreak, and eliminate pollution all the while turning CO2 into precious oxygen; and

WHEREAS, Neighborhood Forest gives kids and families an easy and fun way to reduce their carbon footprint by planting trees; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County Library System (the "Library") wishes to allow Neighborhood Forest to arrange for tree distribution within Clayton County Library Service's normal functioning working hours; and

WHEREAS, Neighborhood Forest will provide a registration link/portal for parents to Clayton County Library Service who will get this link out to parents in the library community (via email, social media, etc); and

WHEREAS, Clayton County Library Service will arrange to get the trees in\*the hands of registered children on or around Earth Day (April 22nd); and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by approving the special use facility request for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of Clayton County Library Services, to allow Neighborhood Forest to arrange for tree distribution within Clayton County Library Service's normal functioning working hours. The Board of Commissioners further requires Neighborhood Forest to make citizens aware of the requirements of the County's tree protection ordinance. The Board also authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

SO RESOLVED, this the 6 day of April, 2021.




