RESOLUTION NO. 2021-103

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHAIRMAN JEFFREY E. TURNER TO PARTNER WITH COMMUNITY ALTERNATIVE TREATMENT SERVICES, INC., AND WOMEN OVER FIFTY AND WOMEN UNDER FIFTY, INC. TO HOST A JUNETEENTH CELEBRATION TO COMMEMORATE THE ENDING OF SLAVERY IN THE UNITED STATES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Community Alternative Treatment Services, Inc. ("CATS") and Women Over Fifty and Women Under Fifty Inc. ("WOF") desires to host a Juneteenth Celebration to commemorate the ending of slavery (the "Event"); and

WHEREAS, CATS and WOF, in partnership with Chairman Jeffrey E. Turner, wishes to use the South Clayton Recreation Center parking lot to host the event (the "Facility"); and

WHEREAS, the Event is scheduled for June 19, 2021 from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Facility will be utilized between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Event will have live music, food, and vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Event will be free and open to the public but vendor fees will apply; and

WHEREAS, during the Event there will be a kickball tournament and car and bike show;

and

WHEREAS, Clayton County Parks & Recreation, Police & Emergency Services will provide support to the Event; and

WHEREAS, the Event is an opportunity for the community to fellowship and celebrate freedom and our nations progression since slavery ended; and

WHEREAS, this Event will promote unity and community activism; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by granting the Request to use the Facility for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Chairman Jeffrey E. Turner to partner with Community Alternative Treatment Services, Inc. and Women Over Fifty and Women Under Fifty Inc. to host a Juneteenth Celebration ("the Event") at the South Clayton Recreation Center Parking Lot ("the Facility") on June 19, 2021. The Facility will be utilized between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. with live music, food and vendors. The Event will be free and open to the public with food, live music, a kickball tournament, a car and bike show and vendors. Vendor fees will apply. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute any documents and perform any other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners and is contingent upon complete satisfaction of all insurance requirements, if any, prior to the initial event date as provided by the Clayton County Risk Management Department.


