RESOLUTION NO. 2021-163

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT AN EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT TO PURCHASE 300 BRAZOS MOBILE ELECTRONIC CITATION SYSTEM LICENSES AND AN AUTOMATED FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM (AFIS) COMPUTER SYSTEM FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department desires to apply for a grant from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant to purchase 300 Brazos Mobile Electronics Citation System Licenses that would be utilized on sworn officer's laptops and an Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) to enhance fingerprint processing and identification in the amount of \$151,899.00; and

WHEREAS, there is no local match required of Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will be best served by participating in this grant and purchasing the computer systems specified therein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Clayton County Police Department to apply for and accept a grant from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Number O-BJA-2021-35004, CFDA-16.738, to purchase 300 Brazos Mobile Electronic Citation System Licenses and an Automated Fingerprint Identification System in the amount of \$151,899.00 with no matching County funds.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the grant agreement and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the grant agreement.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
