RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 208

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COMMISSIONER FELICIA FRANKLIN TO PARTNER WITH DR. YVETTE CROSSING TO HOST AN EVENT CELEBRATING JUNETEENTH BECOMING A NATIONAL HOLIDAY THROUGH THE ARTISTIC DISPLAY OF "SCARS AND STRIPES" AT THE FLINT RIVER COMMUNITY CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Commissioner Felicia Franklin desires to host an event celebrating Juneteenth becoming a national holiday through artistic expression (the "Event"); and

WHEREAS, Dr. Yvette Crossing, in partnership with Commissioner Felicia Franklin, wishes to use the Flint River Community Center, Black Box Theater (the "Facility") to host the event celebrating her artistic display of "Scars and Stripes"; and

WHEREAS, the Event is scheduled for November 6, 2021, from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Event will include performances by local Clayton County community members; and

WHEREAS, the "Scars and Stripes" display by Dr. Yvette Crossing will continue to appear at the Flint River Community Center, along with artistic expressions from Clayton County community members and students in partnership with Clayton County Schools Fine Arts Division; and

WHEREAS, the Event is an opportunity for the community to fellowship and celebrate our nation's progress since the end of slavery through artistic expression; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best served by granting the Request to use the Facility for the above stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Commissioner Felicia Franklin to partner with Dr. Yvette Crossing to host an event celebrating Juneteenth through the artistic display of “Scars and Stripes” at the Flint River Community Center, Black Box Theater on November 6, 2021, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.


