ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 268

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, PART I, CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION", ARTICLE III "BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND AUTHORITIES," DIVISION 6 "LICENSE REVIEW BOARD" BY REPEALING AND DELETING SECTION 2-90.4 "INITIATING OF PROCEEDINGS; CAUSE FOR SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION," SUBSECTION (A) AND SUBSTITUTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION 2-90.4 "INITIATING OF PROCEEDINGS; CAUSE FOR SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION," SUBSECTION (A); TO AUTHORIZE THE WARDEN TO INITIATE PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE LICENSE REVIEW BOARD; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The Code of Clayton County, Georgia, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part I, Chapter 2 "Administration", Article III "Boards, Commissions and Authorities," Division 6 "License Review Board" by repealing and deleting Section 2-90.4 "Initiating of proceedings; cause for suspension or revocation," subsection (a) and substituting in lieu thereof a new section 2-90.4 "Initiating of proceedings; cause for suspension or revocation," subsection (a) to read as follows:

Sec. 2-90.4. - Initiating of proceedings; cause for suspension or revocation.

(a) The chief of police, the warden or the director of the department of community development may initiate enforcement proceedings of the LRB by written complaint to the LRB chairperson with a copy to the county

attorney. No member of LRB shall have the power to initiate such enforcement proceedings.

Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


