ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 273

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, CHAPTER 94 "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES", ARTICLE III "PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING" BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 94-65 "PARKING NOT TO OBSTRUCT TRAFFIC"; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The Code of Clayton County, Georgia, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Chapter 94 "Traffic and Vehicles", Article III "Parking, Stopping and Standing" by adding a new section 94-65 "Parking not to obstruct traffic" to read as follows:

Sec. 94-65. - Parking not to obstruct traffic.

Every vehicle parked upon a street shall be parked in such a manner or under such conditions so as to leave available no less than twelve feet of the width of the roadway for free movement of vehicular and emergency vehicle traffic between vehicles. It shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this section for there to be less than twelve feet of space between vehicles parked on both sides of the roadway. Provided, however, County police officers, the sheriff and deputy sheriffs shall not be required to cite both vehicles if it can be determined which vehicle was the last to park in such a manner to cause the violation.


Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


