RESOLUTION NO. 2022-82

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH GEORGIA TECH'S CENTER FOR SERVE-LEARN-SUSTAIN PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSES OF CREATING A CLIMATE VULNERABILITY ANALYSIS FOR CLAYTON COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Fire& Emergency Services (the "CCFEMS") wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with Georgia Tech's Center for Serve-Learn-Sustain program for the purposes of creating a Climate Vulnerability Analysis for Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, Georgia Tech's Serve-Learn-Sustain program allows students of the university to conduct an analysis of Clayton County's sustainability; and

WHEREAS, through this analysis, the team of students will gather information on the most vulnerable aspects of Clayton, such as floodplains or food deserts, as well as Clayton's most valuable assets, like public transit, in order to recommend solutions that will mitigate the vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, the project will be completed by the Georgia Tech Sustainable Cities Studio class, which is comprised of a team of various majors and backgrounds that bring a wide range of expertise towards any recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the team will explore historical and empirical data and develop a plan that includes interactive GIS mapping, and create a website with all the information gathered for online viewing; and

WHEREAS, this program has completed a successful project for Dekalb County in the summer of 2021; and

WHEREAS, there is no cost to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by entering into the Memorandum of Understanding with Georgia Tech's Center for Serve-Learn-Sustain program for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Georgia Tech's Center for Serve-Learn-Sustain program for the purposes of creating a Climate Vulnerability Analysis for Clayton County. The Memorandum of Understanding shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A", subject to such minor changes, insertions, or deletions as the County Attorney and/or Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman, or his designee, to execute the Agreement, with such minor changes, insertions, or deletions, and otherwise to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
