RESOLUTION NO. 2022-86

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF GEORGIA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR THE CLAYTON COUNTY DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE AND DRUG ACCOUNTABILITY COURT PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (the "County"), on behalf of the Clayton County Driving Under the Influence and Drug Accountability Court Program (the "DUI Court"), has been awarded grant funds in the amount of \$50,544.00 ("Grant") from the State of Georgia Criminal Justice Coordinating Council ("CJCC"), and the County now wishes to accept those funds; and

WHEREAS, there is a minimal financial impact to the County of a 12% cash match totaling \$6,892.36; and

WHEREAS, DUI Court is a four-phase intervention program that involves group and individual therapy sessions, bi-monthly court appearances, probation supervision, random drug testing, and home surveillance visits for a minimum period of 12 months; and

WHEREAS, the Grant funds will also provide for a Program Case Manager, as well

as eight (8) DUI Court team members to attend the CJCC Judges Conference for training;
and

WHEREAS, accepting this grant award will support and reduce costs to the County's budget for alcohol and substance abuse treatment services, field and in-person monitoring, and mandatory training; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is July 1, 2022, until June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by accepting the grant funds, as described above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept grant funds in the amount of \$50,544.00 on behalf of the Clayton County Driving Under the Influence and Drug Accountability Court Program for the purpose of supporting program needs with a \$6,892.36 local cash match required from the County.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute all necessary documents, and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 3. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense as necessary.
