RESOLUTION NO. 2022-88

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF GEORGIA COUNCIL OF ACCOUNTABILITY COURT JUDGES FUNDING COMMITTEE AND THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR THE CLAYTON COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ACCOUNTABILITY COURT PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (the "County"), on behalf of the Clayton County Behavioral Health Accountability Court Program (the "Court"), has been awarded grant funds in the amount of \$156,214.00 from the State of Georgia Criminal Justice Coordinating Council ("CJCC"), and the County now wishes to accept those funds; and

WHEREAS, the County's required local cash match totaling \$30,000.00, is a relatively small financial impact upon the County measured against the funds awarded; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is July 1, 2022, until June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Court is a four-phase intervention program that involves intensive group and individual counseling, weekly court appearances, probation supervision, random drug testing, and home surveillance visits for a minimum period of 18 months; and

WHEREAS, the Grant funds will also provide for a Program Case Manager, counseling services, peer support services, transportation, as well as, eight (8) Court team members to attend the CJCC Judges Conference for training; and

WHEREAS, accepting this grant award will support and reduce costs to the County's budget for substance abuse treatment services, surveillance, participant transportation, and mandatory training; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by accepting the grant funds, as described above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept grant funds in the amount of \$156,214.00 on behalf of the Clayton County Behavioral Health Accountability Court Program, for the purpose of supporting program needs, with a \$30,000.00 local match required from the County.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute all necessary documents, and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense as necessary.


Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




