RESOLUTION NO. 2022-91

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH VISION TO LEARN TO PROVIDE VISION SERVICES TO CLAYTON COUNTY COMMUNITIES; TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY TO HOST THE WORKSHOPS AT THE COUNTY'S LIBRARY LOCATIONS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County, through the Clayton County Library System (the "Library"), wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with Vision To Learn ("VTL") to provide vision service to Clayton County communities; and

WHEREAS, students will receive a basic vision examination, prescription and fitting of glasses at no cost to the family; and

WHEREAS, VTL has helped provide more than 1.2 million children with vision screenings, 300,000 with eye exams and almost 250,000 with glasses, in more than 500 underserved communities across the country; and

WHEREAS, there is no cost to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by entering into the Memorandum of Understanding with Vision to Learn for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Vision To Learn to provide vision services to Clayton County communities. The Memorandum of Understanding shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A", subject to such minor changes, insertions, or deletions as the County Attorney and/or

Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the workshops to be offered at the Clayton County Library locations. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman, or his designee, to execute the Agreement, with such minor changes, insertions, or deletions, and otherwise to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
