RESOLUTION NO. 2022-220

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A DEMOLITION PERMIT FOR KISSBERG CONSTRUCTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County is the owner of parcels 1324 1B B017 and 1324 1B B001 whose property addresses are 120 and 124 Smith Street, Jonesboro Georgia 30236 (“Properties”); and

WHEREAS, Clayton County Building and Maintenance Department is requesting approval for the County’s signature for a demolition permit that was awarded to Kissberg Construction (“Kissberg”) to demolish structures on these two County parcels; and

WHEREAS, Kissberg needs the County’s signature as owners of the Properties to move forward with the demolition of said structures; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by executing the demolition permit for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of the Clayton County Building and Maintenance, to sign and execute the demolition permit for Kissberg Construction to move forward with demolishing structures located on Parcels 1324 1B B017 and 1324 1B B001 whose property addresses are 120 and 124 Smith

Street, Jonesboro Georgia 30236. The Board also authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
