RESOLUTION NO. 2022-249

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE GEORGIA RECREATION PARKS ASSOCIATION FOR THE COACHING BOYS TO MEN PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE GRANT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Parks and Recreation Department wishes to accept grant funds in the amount of up to \$20,000.00 from the Georgia Recreation Parks Association; and

WHEREAS, the funding was provided to Clayton County for hosting and participating in the Coaching Boys to Men Program (“Program”); and

WHEREAS, the Program builds healthy relationship skills for youth and is funded through a Cooperative Agreement from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and

WHEREAS, the Program awarded \$5,000.00 per site and Clayton County Parks and Recreation has four sites participating: Carl Rhodenizer, Virginia Gray, South Clayton, and Jim Huie Recreation Centers; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to purchase program supplies for future programs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will be best served by authorizing Clayton County to accept the grant funding for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Clayton County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept grant funds in the amount of up to \$20,000 from the Georgia Recreation Parks Association. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman or his designee to execute any documents and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the grant.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
