RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 254

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT TO TRANSFER THE LOANED SURPLUS BELL OH-58C AND SURPLUS HELICOPTER PARTS FOR THE OH-58C TO THE HENRY COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, AS APPROVED BY THE GEORGIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (GEMA); TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR HIS DESIGNEE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department (the Department) previously received the Bell OH-58C helicopter on loan from the Georgia Emergency Management Agency (GEMA) as military surplus; and

WHEREAS, after the purchase of the Bell 407 GXI helicopter under SPLOST, the Department no longer has need or hanger storage capacity for the OH-58C; and

WHEREAS, GEMA has approved the transfer of the OH-58C aircraft to the Henry County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, with the transfer of the OH-58C, the surplus parts for the OH-58C are no longer needed and will be transferred with the aircraft to the Henry County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial impact to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will be best served by authorizing the Police Department to transfer the loaned Bell OH-58C helicopter and helicopter parts to the Henry County Sheriff's Office.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED.

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County, through the Police Department, to transfer the loaned Bell OH-58C helicopter and associated helicopter parts to Henry County Sheriff's Office, as approved by the Georgia Emergency Management Agency (GEMA). The Board further authorizes the Chairman or his designee to execute any documents and perform any acts necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
