RESOLUTION NO. 2022-270

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY SHERIFF; TO PROVIDE FOR AND MODIFY THE SUPPLEMENTAL COMPENSATION OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY SHERIFF; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners recognizes that certain Clayton County elected officials are performing duties essential to County operations and have significant responsibilities, therefore additional compensation for their responsibilities is warranted; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2021-41, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners authorized supplemental compensation for certain Clayton County elected officials to include the Clayton County Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, from June 2021 through October 31, 2022, Roland Boehrer has performed the duties of interim Sheriff of Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2022, Roland Boehrer received a supplement in the amount of \$10,422.32 for performing the duties of interim Sheriff of Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, following former Sheriff Victor Hill's retirement in November 2022, Roland Boehrer was sworn in as interim Sheriff by state law; and

WHEREAS, based on his years of service and tenure, his salary as Chief Deputy exceeds the incoming salary of a newly elected Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, to prevent him from suffering a financial loss by being promoted to Sheriff, the County desires to set Roland Boehrer's salary and clarify the impact of the

supplemental compensation awarded in May 2022 and as set forth in Resolution 2021-41;  
and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Clayton County to establish and otherwise set Roland Boehrer's salary consistent with the stated goals above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby establishes Roland Boehrer's annual salary as \$149,035.47 to be paid monthly. Said salary shall remain in place until such time that the winning candidate for the special election to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term of Victor Hill is decided. Furthermore, the Board hereby rescinds the \$10,422.32 supplement provided to Boehrer on May 3, 2022 for performing the duties of interim Sheriff of Clayton County. The supplemental compensation for the office of the Sheriff as set forth in Exhibit A attached to Resolution 2021-41 is also hereby suspended until such time that the winning candidate for the special election to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term of Victor Hill is decided.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby clarifies that, once the winning candidate for the special election to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term of Victor Hill is decided, the supplement for the office of Sheriff as set forth in Exhibit A to Resolution 2021-41 shall attach in accordance with all applicable state and local laws and, specifically, shall only be increased, reduced or eliminated in accordance with all applicable state and local laws.


Section 3. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense as may be required to carry out the terms of this Resolution.

Section 4. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.


Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
