RESOLUTION NO. 2022-275

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, THROUGH ITS FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES DEPARTMENT, TO ACCEPT A SUPPLEMENTAL UPPER PAYMENT LIMIT AWARD FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE STATE SHARE OF MEDICAID SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENTS FOR AMBULANCE PROVIDERS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Health (“DCH”) received approval through the Georgia House Bill 271 (“H.B. 271”) from the 2021-2022 regular session of the Georgia Assembly to develop an assessment program for the purpose of funding the state share of Medicaid supplemental payments for ambulance providers; and

WHEREAS, the DCH submitted the SFY 2023 Ground Ambulance payments Upper Payment Limit calculation to Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (“CMS”) for acceptance; and

WHEREAS, DCH will release an interim supplemental payment to eligible Ambulance providers while we wait final acceptance from CMS; and

WHEREAS, the total Interim supplemental payment is \$705,548.32 with the federal share being \$509,547.00 and state share is \$196,001.32; and

WHEREAS, the County will pay the state share and in return receive the federal share; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by accepting the grant funds for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, through its Fire & Emergency Services department, to accept a supplemental Upper Payment Limit award from the Department of Community Health for the purpose of funding the State share of Medicaid supplemental payments for ambulance providers in the amount of \$509,547.00. The Board further authorizes the County to pay the State share of \$196,001.32 through an Intergovernmental Transfer.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman or his designee to execute any documents and to perform such other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required by the grant.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
