RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 121

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO RENEW THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE U.S. MARSHAL'S OFFICE TO CONTINUE THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN A REGIONAL FUGITIVE TASK FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE MOU AS REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE MOU; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MOU; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Marshal's Office operates a Regional Fugitive Task Force with participation from various area law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the County police department has participated in this valuable program since 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by continuing to participate in this Regional Fugitive Task Force.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the
Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, or the Chief of Police as the

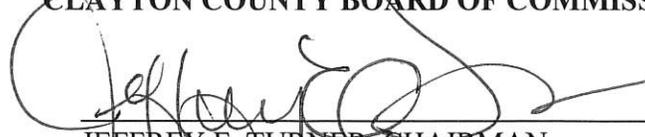
Chairman's designee, to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the U.S. Marshall's Office to continue the County's participation in the Regional Fugitive Task Force. The U.S. Marshall's Office may provide a vehicle and radio for the County employee assigned to the Task Force. Additionally, the U.S. Marshal's Office will reimburse the County for overtime payments subject to the availability of funds. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

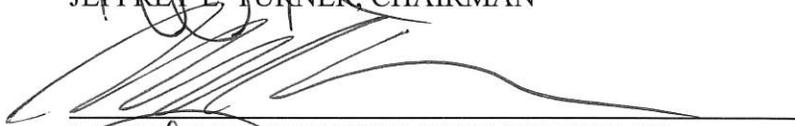

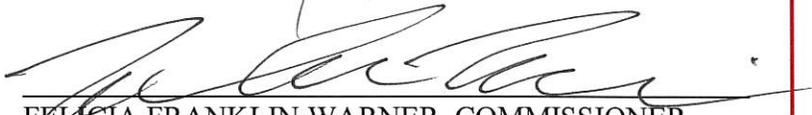
