A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE AEROATL GREENWAY PLAN;
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALING INCONSISTENT
RESOLUTIONS, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) has collaborated with
several counties and municipalities in preparing the AeroATL Greenway Plan; and

WHEREAS, the ARC Board has allocated \$500 million for transportation
projects resulting from completed Livable Centers Initiative studies; and

WHEREAS, the AeroATL Greenway Plan was developed in consultation with
relevant staff representing Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the AeroATL Greenway Plan was developed with input from
citizens living within the study area that includes portions of Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the AeroATL Greenway Plan makes the study
area eligible for additional transportation funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners supports the recommendations
identified in the AeroATL Greenway Plan which is attached as Exhibit A hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believes that supporting the
AeroATL Greenway Plan would promote the health, safety, and welfare of, the
citizens of the County.




