Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby abolishes the position of Deputy Chief Operating Officer effective January 2, 2019. The effective date of the termination shall be January 17, 2019.


Section 2. The Director of Human Resources is instructed to notify the Civil Service Board of the abolishment of the position.
