RESOLUTION NO. 2019 – 18

A RESOLUTION TO ABOLISH THE MARKETING AND COMMUNICATIONS SUPERINTENDENT POSITION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to abolish and rescind the creation of the Marketing and Communications Superintendent position in the Department of Parks and Recreation that was created at the last meeting of the Board of Commissioners held December 18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believes that there are insufficient funds available to fund the position and there is insufficient work to warrant the creation of the position; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the County's best interest and the County will best be served by rescinding the resolution and abolishing the position.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby abolishes the position of Marketing and Communications Superintendent effective January 2, 2019.

Section 2. The Director of Human Resources is instructed to notify the Civil Service Board of the abolishment of the position.

Section 3. In the event the position has been filled prior to the effective date of this Resolution, the Director of Parks and Recreation is instructed to notify the person filling the position in writing that they will be terminated effective two (2) weeks

following the effective date of this Resolution, and to provide the Director of the Human Resources with a copy of said notice.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


